Hanson Riding Club Supreme Invitational

Rules & Regulations

- Invitation is extended to the top 3 placings in each class and Division Champion and Reserve Champion at each qualifying show. Same horse and rider combination must show at more than 1 show to be eligible
- Qualifying riders are asked to pre-enter by September 16th 2017 to be included in the showbook.
- Post entries (after September 21st) will incur an additional fee of \$25.
- Classes will only run if there are 2 pre-entries for that class the Friday before the show (Sept.21st).
- Rider/horse combinations must be the same as those that qualified.
- Rider may only ride in the level (leadline, walk/trot or walk/trot/canter) they qualified in.
- If a rider moves up in riding level after they qualify, they must re-qualify at appropriate level.
- Rider may qualify in a games class however they must show at their appropriate riding level.
- The show will have a modified class list.
- All qualifier classes (Ideal, Equitation, Pleasure) will have an entry fee of \$20
- All Supreme classes (excluding Supreme Trail) will be filled by the top 3 pinning riders in Equitation and Pleasure classes. Top 6 Ideal placings may show back in the corresponding Leadline, Driving, and Therapeutic Supremes. There is no entry fee for these classes.
- There is no entry fee for the Showmanship Challenge but you must qualify at one of the HRC Open Shows.
- On the day of the show, riders may add or drop classes only before receiving their number. After that time, no changes will be made.
- Please refer to Hanson Riding Club Open Show rules for all other questions.

Trail Supreme

- Trail class may be entered by all riders that have qualified according to Supreme rules (see above) for an entry fee of \$20.
- Entrants must ride at their qualifying riding level (In-hand, leadline, walk/trot or walk/trot/canter).
- Entrants will be divided by their riding level only, not by ages or riding styles.
- Horse and Rider combination may only enter the trail class once.
- \$20 entry for Trail Supreme (In-hand, Leadline, W/T or WTC level)
- One Supreme Trail Champion for In-Hand
- One Supreme Trail Champion for Leadline
- One Supreme Trail Champion for Walk/Trot
- One Supreme Trail Champion for Walk/Trot/Canter
